### **RECRUITING FOR CENSUS:**

Census 2010 recruiting efforts have resumed and Complete Count Committees may now begin their recruiting efforts. Wed need more than

3 million applicants nation wide, and expect to hire 1.4 million workers. This means we need thousands of applicants from our region.

Interested residents may call our recruiting hotline to apply for a job: 1-866-861-2010. They may also call the Edwardsville office directly: 618-307-3730. Census Takers, or Enumerators, will earn \$11.50/hour and will be reimbursed for mileage. Pay and job duration will vary with the position. Applicants must be at least 18 years old and pass a background test. Selected applicants will be fingerprinted.
