MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING ON:
WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 24, 2018

A special meeting of the President and Board of Trustees was held on Wednesday October 24, 2018 at 7:30pm at the Village Hall. In attendance were Village President Dale Haukap, Village Administrator Mike Buscher, Village Clerk Jennifer Jansen, Trustees Larry Harper, Randy Peek, Gary Litteken and Kurt Schmitz. Guests included Scott Voyles of the Aviston Zoning Board.

1. Approval of bid on Rt. 50 & Russland Road:

Mike Buscher spoke with the contractor currently working on the Rt. 50 Project about submitting a bid to work on the aprons of Russland Road. The contractor stated that in speaking with his boss, they will not be submitting a bid for such work as there is no engineering study and they have no idea what they would be getting into. Mike also informed the Board that Pat Netemeyer will get in touch with IDOT to see if we can do this on our own.

2. Frontier Industrial Park Resolution:

Mike Buscher informed the Board that he met with Troy & Jan Kapp regarding putting up a storage building in the Industrial Park. Kurt did a search in the ordinance book and found that storage facilities of any kind are not listed anywhere in our Code. Pat Netemeyer entered the meeting. Time was 7:40pm. Kurt discussed the idea of addressing this issue over the next several months to get added to the Ordinance Book. Jenny is to put this on the November agenda. Kevin Eversgerd entered the meeting. Time was 8:12pm. The Village Board recapped the meeting for Kevin.
