Effective June 1^{st} a new ordinance went into effect regarding golf carts and off-highway vehicles (ATVs/UTVs). You must now obtain a permit and sticker to be able to drive them on the Village streets. Cost is \$35 per permit. Permits are good for 1-year, effective June 1st – May 31^{st} .

Due to the ordinance being in effect, the Aviston Police Department will now be issuing tickets to those that do not have the permit stickers displayed. Also remember ---- you must be 18 to drive a UTV on Village streets. These vehicles are not to be driven on sidewalks.

If you are planning on adding/changing your residence or business (i.e. fence, patio, patio enclosure, deck, basically anything that is permanent in your yard except basketball poles, swing sets, etc.), you need to get a zoning permit. If you have any questions when making changes to the exterior of your business or residence, please call the Village Hall for assistance.

Large trash pickup is not scheduled again until October. If you have a large trash item that needs to get picked up, you may call Republic Services, personally, and request/schedule the pickup. The number to call is: (618) 656-6883. If you have something that needs to get in the newsletter, please submit it to the Village Hall before the Village Board meeting (1st Monday of the month). The newsletter gets finalized, printed. and mailed within 2-3 days after the meeting. Thank you for your cooperation.

<u>Parking issues.</u> Please be sure you are parking correctly (on the right side) along the streets. Also, do not park in 'NO PARKING' zones. It is illegal to park any RV, trailer, boat, etc. on a Village street.
