## VILLAGE NEWS:

### HELP WANTED

Part-time cleaning person for the Vintage Hall. Responsibilities include making sure that the hall is clean, trash taken out, etc. after bookings and acceptable for new rentals. Applications can be picked up at the Village Hall. Position will be effective January 15, 2020.

### ORV STICKERS

A new supply of stickers has been received. If you still need a sticker to legally drive your ORV on village streets, visit us at the Village Hall. Cost is \$35 per permit and good through the end of May. Renewals will be required starting June 1<sup>st</sup>.

### VINTAGE HALL

The Vintage Hall is available for rent for any Aviston resident. New rules as of January 1, 2020: rental fee will be \$75 and the deposit fee is \$100. These fees will need to be paid when the reservation is made. **The reservation is not confirmed until the deposit AND rent is paid in full.** (For those who have already reserved a date (and not paid) for 2020, you will be getting a phone call for these fees). If the reservation is canceled, the Village will keep the rental fee. When renting the building, please keep in mind that you are in a residential area and that outside entertainment (music, etc.) must be kept to a minimum so residents are not disrupted.

### BOOKINGS FOR PARK PAVILIONS AND VINTAGE HALL

As of January 1, 2020, all bookings for the park pavilions will be on a rolling calendar year (same as the Vintage Hall). You may only book it for 1 year from the current date (no earlier).
