This survey is required by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and must be completed by all water customers.

Dear Water Customer,

The purpose of this survey is to determine whether a cross-connection may exist at your home or business. A cross-connection is an unprotected or improper connection to the public water distribution system that may cause contamination or pollution to enter the system. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) and the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) are responsible for enforcing cross-connection regulations.

- Every customer served by the public water system must be surveyed. This survey includes identifying what plumbing fixtures are present in the home or business and what uses the water is being put to.
- You may complete this survey on our website at www.avistonil.org and clicking on the appropriate link, or by completing the form on the reverse side of this paper and returning to the Village Hall.
- After we receive this survey back, we will review the data and determine whether an inspection of your plumbing is needed. If this is the case, you will be notified by mail.

This survey is required by the IEPA and must be completed by all water customers. We thank you in advance for your cooperation on this matter. If you have any questions, please contact the Village Hall at 228-7262.
