Effective June 1<sup>st</sup> a new ordinance has gone into effect regarding golf carts and off-highway vehicles (ATVs/UTVs). You must now obtain a permit and sticker to be able to drive them on the Village streets. Cost is \$35 per permit. Permits are good for 1-year, effective June 1<sup>st</sup> – May 31<sup>st</sup>. Stickers will be available approximately June 17<sup>th</sup>.
