Street oiling will be August 19th. Please remove any vehicles from the streets designated to be oiled and chipped.

The Village of Aviston shut off policy for all water customers has been changed a slight bit. If your water is shut off due to non-payment, your service will be reconnected the next business day AFTER payment is made. Please do NOT expect to have your water service restored immediately after payment is made.

The Vintage Hall is available for rent for any Aviston resident. The fees for this for 2019 are \$100 deposit and a \$50 rental fee. January 1, 2020 the rental fee will be increased to \$75 and the deposit amount will remain unchanged. When renting the building, please keep in mind that you are in a residential area and that outside entertainment (music, etc.) must be kept to a minimum so residents are not disrupted.

NEW CROSSWALK FLASHING LIGHTS

Beware of the new flashing lights at crosswalks on 4th & Clinton Streets (by the Feed Mill) and also Rt. 50 & Spring St. (Casey's). Pedestrians have the right-of-way. Please watch for them --- we don't want to see anyone get hurt.

Due to the Off-Road Vehicle (ORV) ordinance being in effect, the Aviston Police Department will now be issuing tickets to those that do not have the permit stickers displayed. Also remember ---- you must be 18 to drive a UTV on Village streets. These vehicles are not to be driven on sidewalks. Large trash pickup is not scheduled again until October. If you have a large trash item that needs to get picked up, you may call Republic Services, personally, and request/schedule the pickup. The number to call is: (618) 656-6883.
