VILLAGE NEWS:

(The front (South) portion is only available for use currently until Thanksgiving due to the ladies working on Christmas lights in the north portion) January 1, 2020 the rental fee will be increased to \$75 and the deposit amount will remain unchanged. When renting the building, please keep in mind that you are in a residential area and that outside entertainment (music, etc.) must be kept to a minimum so residents are not disrupted.
