The Village of Aviston's community water system (CWS) finished in the Top 5 in the Illinois Rural Water Association (IRWA) Best Tasting Water contest.

The contest was held at the 38th annual IRWA technical conference in Effingham, IL on February 18 - 20, 2020. The winner is given to a CWS based on scoring by a panel of unbiased judges in a "double blind" water taste test. **Out of all entries, Aviston's entry was the 4th best tasting water overall in the State of Illinois.**

The winner of the IRWA Best Tasting Water contest represents Illinois in the Great American Water Taste Test at the National Rural Water Association "Rural Water Rally" in Washington, D.C. in 2021.

Illinois Rural Water Association (IRWA) began October 1979. IRWA was formed to coordinate water and wastewater system programs on a statewide basis. The primary goal of the Association is professional, efficient operation of water and wastewater systems through education and on-site assistance, working on a one-to-one basis, and addressing problems from the system level.
