- ✔ Drainage completed by Markus Excavating
- ✓ Old Scoreboard removed
- ✓ New Scoreboard assembled and installed
- ✔ Building gutter system cleaned out and tied into main drain
- ✓ Speaker wire fished into building and ran in conduit to field
- ✓ 12-2 wire ran to dugouts, fished into dugouts and backstop
- ✓ GFI's installed and power turned on
- Footings poured
- ✔ Poles installed behind backstop
- ✔ Removed old yellow cap on the fence
- ✓ Net Ordered 28 feet by 64.9 feet
- ✓ Stereo / Speakers / PA Ordered
- ✓ Concrete footing set up to pour concrete pad (April 2)
- ✓ Test sprinklers (wire may have torn during drain install)
- ✓ Install drainage behind home plate backstop
- ✓ Finish pouring concrete pads
