

POLICE DEPARTMENT

The Village has passed a revised the Village Ordinance of Nuisances/Garbage & Debris and the Police Department will be enforcing residents to abide by the ordinance. The entire ordinance is available on our website at www.avistonil.org. If you don't have a computer and would like a copy of the ordinance, you may visit the Village Hall and obtain a copy.

REMINDER: There is a crosswalk at the corner of 4th St. & Clinton St. (Aviston/Albers Rd). There are signs at both sides of the street with a push button to assist pedestrians to cross which will light up the sign. Please use the push buttons to help you cross the street. These buttons should be used for ANYONE crossing the street (walkers/bicycles).

2023 CONSOLIDATED ELECTION

The 2023 Consolidated Election is scheduled for April 4, 2023. Petitions for the elected office may be circulated starting September 20, 2022. The filing period for the election is December 12-19, 2022. Each candidate has a petition signature requirement of 40-90 signatures.

The Village of Aviston will have 3 Trustee positions up for election.

As many Ameren customers have seen on your power bills, the cost for electricity has risen significantly. The Village has been fielding many calls regarding this and what we, as the Village of Aviston, are doing to assist in mitigating these rising costs. The Village of Aviston is currently not in a municipal aggregation consortium that offers a contracted secondary power supplier (e.g., HomeField Energy); however, the Village is exploring available options to address immediate concerns as well as for the future. As more details and/or options become available, we will readily communicate that information with Village residents.
