Aviston Park Board has begun a park bench program to place benches for seating around our community. These benches can be purchased as a memorial for a loved one, a donation from an entire family, or just a way to help brighten up our community.

If you or someone you know is interested in purchasing a bench, the donation will be **\$1,200**. The Park Board will order the bench, assemble it, and place it throughout our community on a concrete slab.

Included on a 6 foot standard bench can be **2 lines of writing of 32 characters per line**. For example, there is a bench at the city park that reads:

*In Loving Memory of* (19 characters with spaces)  
*Walter "Peepers" Rakers* (23 characters with spaces)
