- ✓ Installed and modified fencing to address safety concerns.
- Installed new rolling doors in the concession stand.
- ✓ Upgrades to concession stand to enhance facility.
- ✓ Total reconstruction of bathroom facilities to make them handicap accessible and up to date.
- Installed Camera's at Kopff Field for overall safety.

Phase 4 - Fall '23 / Spring '24 (Miscellaneous items) - In Progress

- ✓ Till and reseed outfield grass
- ✓ Installed Camera's at upper and lower Aviston Park locations to oversee safety and protect property.
- ✓ Tulips plants around all the benches at the park
- ✓ Replace Tennis Court lights, parking lot lights and playground lights.
- Tree removal, tree trimming, stump removal and tree replacements. (On-going effort over next few years to remove/replace dead and potentially dangerous trees) (Spring '24 - '25)
- Playground mulch added.
- Paint storage shed at park (Spring '24)
- Fix Softball Diamond Sprinkler System (Spring '24)
- Batting cage painting and upgrades (Spring '24)
- Add Additional batting cage by baseball Diamond donated by Aviston Post 1239 (Spring '24)

Phase 5 - Summer/Fall 2024 (Football/Soccer Park) - In Progress

- This would be located across the street from softball diamond.
- Install a 400A 1Ø 480V electric service.
- Dirt Excavation required for parking lot and 2 soccer Fields.
- Drainage pipe installation
- Plant grass and add Fertilizer for soccer fields.
- Purchase 2 Pro-Bound 8'x24' Quick Kick Official Soccer Goals
- Purchase 4 12' Aluminum Team Bench w/ Back, Surface Mount
- Build Parking lot for both Soccer and Football
- Lighting for Football Field, 1 soccer field and the parking lot
- Storage Building / Bathroom 24' by 48' Multipurpose storage and 2 Handicap accessible baths
- Water Fountain Concrete Dual Outdoor Pedestal Drinking Fountain
- Plant a few trees where feasible.

Note: Park Board submitted for a matching grant to assist in funding this effort alongside donations.

Phase 6 -2025 Kopff Field Playground
