 - ✓ Fixed walking path lights fixed.
 - ✓ Park clean-up date – March 30
 - ✓ Playground Mulch (\$25 dollars per big scoop at Plant Land)

 - a. Park Opens April 1 - Water on – No leaks / Kopff Field needed water entry modified.
 - **Park is open after Kopff Field expense for fixing water into concession stand. Emig Plumbing performed the work.**
 - b. Sticky Harem's intention to retire – Cognition plans?
 - **Plaque for Table being engraved and \$200 dollar gift certificate of appreciate to Trenton house is being presented.**
 - **Dennis to contact Sticky Harem on presentation plans**
 - c. Additional trees planted.
 - Neal Richter purchased 3 trees and planted them at the park already. He plans to purchase and plant 3 additional trees this spring.
 - d. OSLAD grant 2024 (update)
 - **Sidewalk Brick thoughts – Troy was not present so on hold until next meeting**
 - **ECO, CCAT and Archeology certificates are complete.**
 - **Dennis to contact state to receive go ahead to fill out paperwork for 50,000 upfront payment.**
 - e. Charge teams for summer.
 - **Cindy Zurliene agreed to contact teams on bills for 2024. It's a nominal cost to assist with lights, chalk and diamond prep.**
 - f. Sell park corner lot?
 - **Discussed option of selling small lot across road from park property**
 - **It is owned by the city, so we would need there approval**

- **Hope is to use funds to enhance park properties.**
- g. Eagle Scout project (gaga pit) - Mark Olsen (567-4108)
 - **BBQ May 31 and Cut sod and pour pad.**
 - **Plan to cut sod for gaga pit within next 2 weeks and pour concrete**
 - **BBQ scheduled for CCL home double header on May 31 to assist with cost associated.**
- h. 2nd Batting Cage (55' long by 14' wide x 12' high)
 - **Plan to cut sod for batting cage within next 2 weeks and pour concrete**
 - **Plan to reuse sod where trees were removed and dog park**
- i. Batting cage Painting / Maintenance
 - **Looking at safe options to get batting cage painted.**
- j. Tennis Court maintenance – Date? Remove old lines?
 - **Cindy Zurliene to call Rooters to discuss timing of resurfacing project.**
 - **Plan is to resurface, seal and repaint to add an additional pickleball court**
- k. Lights at Park - Softball (3 out/Plate), Baseball (7 out /some dim), Kopff (3 out/plate)
 - **Greg Heiman plans to come out within next to weeks to fix bad lights**
 - **Plan to call local construction companies to discuss lift use.**
- l. Softball Sprinklers – Waiting for City to hookup.
 - **Waiting on City to connect water to sprinkler system on softball diamond**
- m. Paint Storage building / Dumpster
 - **Hoping the park workers have availability to paint shed and dumpster**
- n. Dog Park night light
 - **Will be installed within next 2 weeks**
 - **Light will run until 9:30 – 10:00 pm**
- o. Park Bug, Spider and Mosquito spraying (Ken Leach)
 - **Agreed to spray for mosquitos three times a year**
 - **Agreed to spray bugs and spiders in all buildings at start of summer and middle of summer.**

 - **To be discussed at upcoming City board meeting**
 - **Drainage ditch cost (3ft pipe)**
