ORDINANCE # 2024-1-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 7 – DISORDERLY CONDUCT

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Aviston deems it appropriate to amend Chapter 9, Article 1, Section 7, Disorderly Conduct.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Aviston, Clinton County, Illinois as follows:

Disorderly Conduct is hereby amended to include the following:

9-1-7 DISORDERLY CONDUCT

A person commits disorderly conduct when he knowingly:

- (A) Does any act in such unreasonable manner as to alarm or disturb another and to provoke a breach of the peace;
- (B) Transmits or causes to be transmitted in any manner a false report to any public safety agency without the reasonable grounds necessary to believe that transmitting the report is necessary for the safety of the public;
- (C) Transmits or causes to be transmitted in any manner a false report to the Department of Public Health under the Nursing Home Care Act, the Specialized Mental Health Rehabilitation Act of 2013, the ID/DD Community Care Act, or the MC/DD Act;
- (D) Transmits or causes to be transmitted in any manner a false report under Article II of the Public Act 83-1432;
- (E) Enters upon the property of another and for a lewd or unlawful purpose deliberately looks into a dwelling on the property through any window or other opening in it.

Any person(s) in violation of this Section shall be fined seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750).
