CROSS CONNECTION SURVEY

You should have received the Cross-connection survey in the mail about two months ago. This is a mandatory survey that all homeowners and businesses need to fill out and return to the Village Hall. The survey may be completed on our website at www.avistonil.org and clicking the appropriate link at the bottom of the page. This survey is required by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and must be completed by all water customers. **All Landlords** --- please make sure to fill out this paperwork for all of your rental units. This needs to be completed and returned to the Village Hall by **July 31, 2024**. Thank you in advance for your cooperation in this matter.

OFF ROAD VEHICLES (ORV) PERMITS

REMINDER: You must be 16 years of age with a valid driver's license to operate an Off-Road Vehicle (ORV)/ Side-by-side/golf cart on village streets. Please obey all driving laws and be aware of your surroundings. **BE CAUTIOUS!!**

Please make sure you have a current 2024 sticker on the vehicle! **TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED!!**
STOP SIGNS: There are stop signs for a reason – please stop where the signs are posted! **IT'S THE LAW!!**

GRASS CUTTING/YARD WASTE/DUMP

It's grass cutting time! Please do not blow your clippings into the street, in the curbing or on the sidewalks as it clogs up the sewer systems and if it rains, it gets very slick on the roads for cycles. Please cut the grass and blow it back into your own yards.

Please do not leave trash, limbs, and other debris piling up on your property.

You can bring yard waste (leaves, grass, bushes, plants) out to the dump east of the park. **DO NOT** put leaves and grass on the burn pile! They go east of the burn pile. There are signs posted where everything is to be put.

DID YOU KNOW?

Before you put/add ANYTHING to your yard, such as a fence, shed, deck, pool, concrete, etc..... you will likely need a building permit. Call us first if you have any questions. The applications are available on our website or you can visit the Village Hall and pick one up.

SWIMMING POOLS

Summer is here --- if you are planning on having a swimming pool, remember: every swimming pool that is more than two (2) feet deep shall be enclosed by a wall or fence at least 3 ½ ft or 42 inches in height. The fence must be a rigid type fence. The passage through such wall or fence shall be equipped with a gate.

If your pool is smaller and you have a ladder for it --- please remove the ladder when you are not swimming in the pool yourself.

BOY SCOUT NEWS

Aluminum can pick up is the first Saturday of the month, please put cans out on the curb by 9 am. If they miss your cans or you could drop them off yourself, the Scout trailer is located on the east side of the American Legion by the shed. 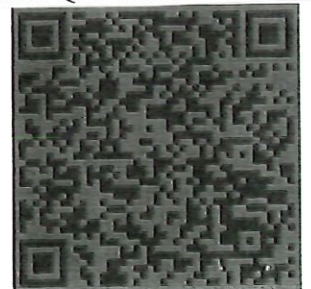
