#### **2025 CONSOLIDATED ELECTION**

The 2025 Consolidated Election is scheduled for April 1, 2025. Petitions for elected offices may be circulated starting August 20, 2024. The filing period for the election is November 12-18, 2024. Each candidate has a petition signature requirement of 41-91 registered voter signatures.

To obtain a petition for the Aviston Village Board (3 positions available plus the Mayor), you will need to contact Jenny at the Village Hall.

#### WATER BILLS AND PAYMENTS

If you ever have questions about your bill, you may contact us at the Village Hall by phone (618)228-7262, ext. 1 or by email at villagehall@avistonil.org.

The best way to pay your bill is to set up an ACH with the Village, cash, cashier's check, or a money order dropped off at our office or mailed directly from you. (we have 2 drop boxes available for your use)

Also, **if you have your bank send in your payment**, make sure that you're leaving plenty of time from when you're submitting it for payment --- some of these are not getting to the Village Hall by the 25<sup>th</sup> and, therefore, are getting late fees assessed.

#### DOGS

There is a dog park by the west pavilion at the park for your use. Please do not just leave your dog in the park while you go for a walk around the track.

Please keep control of your dog, whether it be in your own yard, taking a walk (should be on a leash), or anywhere in public. Not everyone loves dogs and they can get scared of them when they're loose. Here's a few excerpts from the ordinance book:

16-1-3 RUNNING AT LARGE A dog shall be deemed to be running at large, except when under leash, or upon the premises of its owners or under full and complete control of its owner. No dog shall be permitted to run at large within the Village.

16-2-3 DOGS AND CATS IN PUBLIC PLACES (A) Leash Law – All dogs and cats brought into public places shall be placed on a leash or harness.

## Acceptable items included in large item pickups:

#### ACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS

- ➤ Carpet: cut into bundles no longer than 4' in length and 3' in diameter and weighing less than 50 lbs. per bundle
- > Furniture: couches, chairs, dressers, tables, desks, etc.
- > Glass portions of doors/windows: must be broken down and placed into small box marked "glass".
- Mattress sets and box springs: (must be wrapped in plastic with ends wrapped/taped closed.)
- > Appliances
- > Basketball sets/poles, unless they are broken down into section! and no larger than 3' in diameter.















#### UNACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS

- Batteries
- > Concrete and construction material of any kind
- ➤ Electronic waste: televisions, computer monitors/accessories, Mp3 players, DVD/VCRs etc.
- > Fluorescent light bulbs
- Lead/oil-based paint/varnish
- Loose trash or trash in cardboard boxes
- Tires
- > Yard waste
