a) 'The County' (Clint Flowers) Public Hearing – Fence Variance – Clint wishes to put up a fence on the west edge of his property going north and then east to the new building. The front of the fence will align approximately with the front of the building of the Aviston Family Restaurant. All Board members were given a GIS print of the property with all boundary lines highlighted. Discussion was held of the type of material that the fence was to be made out of and Clint stated that he was planning on using either an iron, aluminum or something of the same as to not obstruct the view. It will be approximately 4-6 ft tall. The fence will be 2 ft from the property line in all areas and will not interfere with Route 50 right-of-way. A motion to approve the variance was made by Clayton Renth, seconded by Terry Tebbe. Roll call vote was taken with all voting 'aye'. Amelia Morgan recused herself due to her being an adjacent property owner.
