OFF ROAD VEHICLES (ORV) PERMITS

2025 PERMITS ARE IN!!!

The 2024 permits expired 12/31/24. You need a sticker to legally drive ORVs on village streets. If you are purchasing a renewal sticker, please provide

your 2024 sticker number. Cost is \$35 per permit and good through December 31, 2025.

REMINDER: You must be 16 years of age with a valid driver's license to operate an Off-Road Vehicle (ORV)/ Side-by-side/golf cart on village streets. Please obey all driving laws and be aware of your surroundings. BE CAUTIOUS!!

DOG PARK

Please note that it is the responsibility of the dog owner to not only maintain control of your dog at all times, but to clean up after them as well, including at the dog park. THANK YOU!
