ACH OPTIONS

The Village of Aviston has added another ACH (Automated Clearing House) date for residents to choose from for paying their utility bill. STREET OILING

Streets will be oiled July 15th & 16th. Streets to be oiled will be marked so please remove all vehicles from the street. Please tell others that may be visiting (or babysitting) of this also. Streets scheduled to be oiled are Gennifer Lane, Sunset Hills subdivision, Walnut Hill subdivision, Russland Road, Rose Avenue and Schumacher Road from E Fourth Street to the railroad tracks. An 'All Call' will be sent to help remind everyone of this happening.

STREET PARKING REMINDER

We know that parking on the street can be crowded at times but please be courteous to your fellow neighbors and rural mail carriers ---- do not park really close to their driveways so that they have difficulties backing their cars out nor that mail cannot be delivered to any mailboxes. ALSO --- REMEMBER TO PARK CORRECTLY!

SOLICITORS WITHIN THE VILLAGE

All solicitors within Village limits are required to have a permit issued by the Village of Aviston. If

someone is at your residence, **PLEASE** ask them for their permit. The Village will also advertise on the website and FB page who the permit holder is and what dates they will be in town.

DOG PARK

Do you have a pooch and like to go to the dog park so they can run? Great! But, please pick up after them. Stepping in poop can pose health risks for both dogs and humans. Feces can contain harmful bacteria, viruses, and parasites that can cause illness. Dogs that step in their own poop may be more susceptible to developing skin infections or other health problems. It is important for pet owners to clean up after their dogs and prevent them from stepping in their own feces. As a reminder, dogs are NOT to be unattended. Please stay with your pet!

SWIMMING POOLS

Summer is here --- **14-5-8 SWIMMING POOLS**
(A) No private swimming pool shall be located in any front or side yard or closer than ten (10) feet to any side or rear lot line.
(B) Every swimming pool that is more than two (2) feet deep shall be enclosed by a wall or fence at least 3.5 feet or 42 inches in height. The fence must be a rigid type fence. The passage through such wall or fence shall be equipped with a gate

DID YOU KNOW?

Before you make any change to your residence, such as a fence, shed, deck, pool, concrete, etc..... you will likely need a building permit. Call us first if you have any questions. The applications are available on our website or you can visit the Village Hall and pick one up.

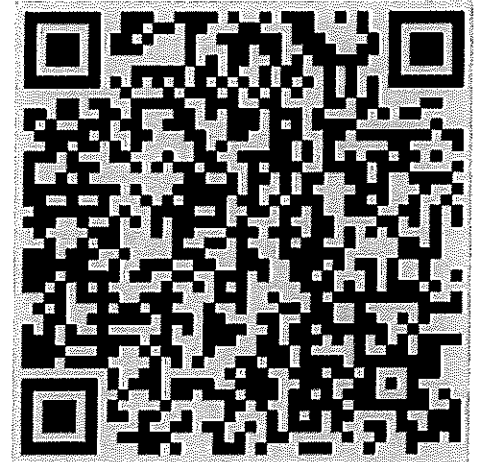

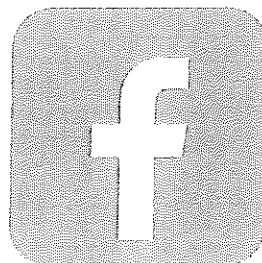
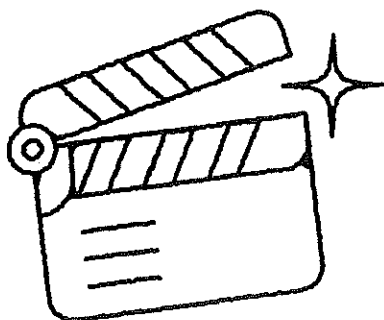
